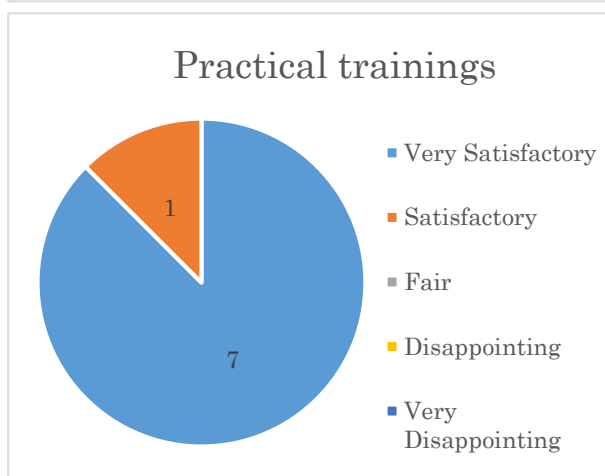

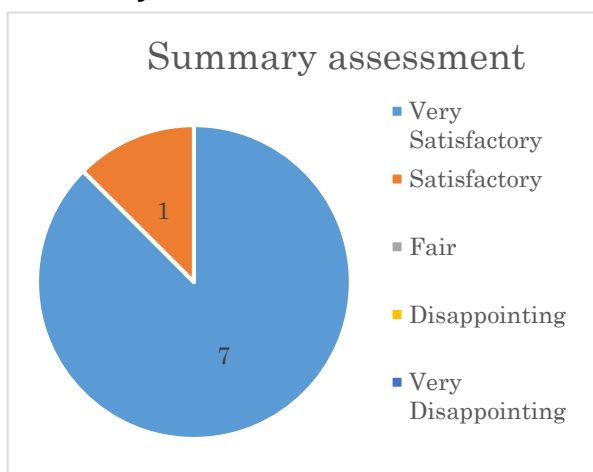
How did you learn that GI-CoRE Summer School was recruiting participants?
